**AB2019-14 TERMINAL APRON RUTTING REPAIR TRENTON-MERCER AIRPORT  
1100 TERMINAL CIRCLE DRIVE, WEST TRENTON, NJ 08628**

**INTENT**

The County of Mercer requests bids for Terminal Apron Rutting Repair for the Trenton-Mercer Airport located at 1100 Terminal Circle Drive, West Trenton, NJ 08628. There is only a base bid for this project. The project will be constructed under a single prime contract. The work will commence in **April 2019**.

**BASE BID AND ALTERNATES**

Refer to the technical specifications and drawings.

The project consists of a base bid to remove the existing asphalt full depth and install concrete pavement. The construction area is at Gate 2 and Gate 3 of the Airport Terminal. The construction includes demolition of asphalt pavement, removal of all materials including soil, prepare a stabilized base course and install 13" thick concrete pavement apron (42' x 56' at each gate) to match existing grade. The concrete shall be tested with a third party special inspection. Proposed asphalt pavement installation will be provided by the owner.

Only one gate can be closed at any time. All work must be completed within the work area prior to re-opening the closed gate.

The County requires all bidders to provide pricing for the base bid. The contractor will be responsible for all required permits and fees. All work to be performed shall be in accordance with the Project Documents, Drawings and Specifications.

**BRAND OR EQUIVALENT**

All references to brand names in the technical specifications shall be interpreted as brand or equivalent.

**EXPERIENCE**

Bidders and subcontractors shall have 5 years' experience in airport pavement construction. Bidders shall provide three (3) verifiable references of projects with a similar scope of work.

**SCHEDULE AND COMPLETION REQUIREMENTS**

Project Substantial Completion: Work will commence within Ten (10) Calendar Days after receipt of written "Notice to Proceed" and be substantially completed within 60 calendar days from the receipt of the Notice to Proceed. Liquidated damages in the amount of \$500.00 per calendar day shall be assessed if the project is not completed within the stated time of completion.
