Whereas, Audrey E. Willis graduated from Trenton Central High School and continued her studies at Mercer County Community College; and

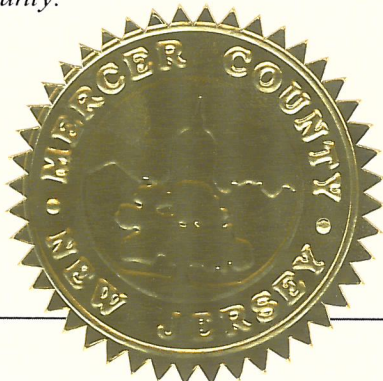
Whereas, Audrey E. Willis retired from General Motors after 34 years of service and from Mercer County, where she was a senior citizen program aide; and
