



WHEREAS, the County of Mercer entered into a contract with East Brunswick AA, LLC, dba AAMCO Transmission., 554 Route 18, East Brunswick, NJ 08816 for Transmission Services for the County of Mercer and the Mercer County Cooperative Contract Purchasing System for a period of one (1) year with an option to extend one (1) year as per Resolution No. 2024-756 adopted on November 14, 2024; and,

WHEREAS, an Option to Extend the original CONTRACT for an additional one (1) year and meeting the requirements of the County specifications for the period of October 1, 2025 through September 30, 2026; and, all other terms and conditions in the original Contract dated November 14, 2024 will remain the same.

# SPECIFICATIONS FOR TRANSMISSION SERVICES FOR THE COUNTY OF MERCER AND THE MERCER COUNTY COOPERATIVE CONTRACT PURCHASING SYSTEM

## **INTENT**

The County of Mercer is seeking bids for vendors to provide repair services to remove, replace, rebuild and re-install the transmissions for various vehicles for the County of Mercer. This contract shall be for a period of one (1) year with an option to extend one (1) year. The option to extend will be contingent on the satisfactory performance from the awarded vendor(s) during the life of the contact. This contract will be awarded to multiple vendors deemed responsive and responsible of whom will offer lowest grand total for each original equipment manufacturer. Original Equipment Manufactured will hereinafter be referred to as OEM. If a vendor provides prices for a specific model under an OEM , **the vendor must provide prices for all models under that OEM to be considered for award.**

## **BASIS OF AWARD**

The awarded vendor will provide the lowest prices for all models under a specific OEM. The award will be based on the grand total for the cost to remove, replace rebuild and re-install for all models under the OEM. Column (D), is the unit cost per the item in column ( C). If there are 2 items in column C the total cost in column (E) is reflected as double the cost. The grand total is based on the figures added together in column ( E).

## **GENERAL REQUIREMENTS**

The County of Mercer may require vehicles towed vendor's facility. The vendor's facility must be no more than forty (40) miles from 300 Scotch Road, West Trenton, New Jersey. The vendor shall have facilities and expertise necessary to properly provide the service set forth in the scope of work. The successful bidder must satisfactorily repair transmissions compliant with the New Jersey Department of Motor Vehicle inspections and maintenance compliance by repairing vehicles to be road ready. The award vendor(s) facilities must be capable of repairing the list of vehicles provided. No escalation of prices will be permitted during the term of the contract. In the event of a manufacturer's price decrease during the contract period, the County of Mercer shall be made aware within 24hrs to contract administrator. The County of Mercer shall receive the full benefit of such price reduction. It is understood by all parties that no guarantees are made as to items or quantities to be purchased no minimum or maximum quantity shall be implied or guaranteed. The County of Mercer will hereinafter be referred to as "The County".

## **REFERENCES**

All prospective bidders shall submit with the bid a list to the County showing past and present performance of work credibility regarding said work and overall reliability. This information will include a list of three references, including a contact person and telephone number.

## SCOPE OF WORK

- All work shall include a minimum three (3) year, and 50,000-mile nationwide warranty.
- Any work on the vehicle other than the repair of the transmission must be approved by the County from the Supervising Mechanic prior to the work being started.
- The County reserves the right to inspect the bidder's establishment before making an award or at any time during the contract period. Vendor shall have up-to-date equipment and tools and be able to provide proof of ability to perform the required work.
- All work must be done on premises. No subcontracting or work off site is allowed.
- The bidder shall assume the responsibility of the County's vehicles while they are on and off the bidder's premises and/or in the car of the vendor and/or the bidder's employees and/or agents.
- **No vehicle will be allowed to be out of service for more than seven (7) working days.** If more time is needed, the Supervising Mechanic of the Motor Pool of the County of Mercer must be contacted for approval. Supervising Mechanic contact information will be provided to the contractor during drop-off.
- The successful bidder shall furnish all labor, materials, equipment, tools and other items necessary to accomplish the required services set forth in the specifications.
- **After repair services is completed, the Supervising Mechanic of the Motor Pool shall have three (3) working days to inspect and give final approval of the repairs and/or refinished vehicle.** If the repair and/or services are not performed to the satisfaction of the Supervising Mechanic, the vehicle will be returned to the vendor for corrective repair service. **All corrective repair service shall be performed at the bidder's expense within five (5) working days of the return of the vehicle to the bidder. If, for some reason, the corrective repair service cannot be performed within the five (5) working days, the bidder must notify the Supervising Mechanic of the Motor Pool in writing with an explanation.**
- The successful bidder will be asked to submit, within three (3) days from the date of receipt of the vehicle, a written estimate of the total cost, listing the parts needed to be replaced and the estimate cost to repair the vehicle based on the agreed upon hourly rates and parts percentage. Only upon written facilities and expertise necessary to properly provide the type of service set forth in this inspection. The successful bidder must satisfactorily repair transmissions; vehicles will be fully road worthy. Their facilities must be capable of repairing the list of vehicles provided.
- Approval by the Supervising Mechanic of the Motor Pool, will the vendor commence with the repairs. The Supervising Mechanic of the Motor Pool will provide the bidder within three working days with a written approval and/or denial of the proposed repair. Under no conditions shall payment for such repairs be made in an amount in excess of that which is quoted in the original estimate, unless agree upon in writing by the Supervising Mechanic of the Motor Pool.

- When determining the hourly rate charged to the County of Mercer for the additional work, which is approved by the County of Mercer, the bidders shall utilize the flat rate book.
- In order to expedite payment to the vendor, a signed voucher (to be supplied by the County) and an original invoice will be given to the County at the time of the delivery of the repaired vehicle.
