**OPTION TO EXTEND FOR THE INSTALLATION OF PAVEMENT MARKERS, RAISED PAVEMENT MARKERS, RUMBLE STRIPS, AND SIGNS ON COUNTY ROADS VARIOUS LOCATIONS FOR THE MERCER COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND INFRASTRUCTURE**

WHEREAS, the County of Mercer entered into a contract with Traffic Lines, Inc., 5100 Asbury Road, Farmingdale, NJ 07727 for the Installation of Pavement Markers, Raised Pavement Markers, Rumble Strips, and Signs on County Roads Various Locations for the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure for a period of one (1) year with an option to extend one (1) year as per Resolution No. 2024-759, adopted November 14, 2024; and,

WHEREAS, an Option to Extend the original CONTRACT for one (1) year and meeting the requirements of the County specifications through October 31, 2026 is required; and, all other terms and conditions in the original Contract dated November 14, 2024 will remain the same.

THE COUNTY reserves the right, at its option to terminate this contract upon giving thirty (30) days written notice to the CONTRACTOR.

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
WHEREAS, the County of Mercer entered into a Contract with Traffic Lines, Inc., 5100 Asbury Road, Farmingdale, NJ 07727 for the installation of pavement markers, raised pavement markers, rumble strips, and signs on County Roads various locations for the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure for a period of one (1) year with an option to extend for one (1) year as per Resolution No. 2024-759, adopted November 14, 2024; and,

WHEREAS, the County of Mercer is desirous of exercising the option to extend the Contract with Traffic Lines, Inc., for the period of November 1, 2025 through December 31, 2026 in the total amount not to exceed \$250,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer of Mercer County has certified in writing the availability of funds, for the purposes set forth in this Resolution, said certification is on file with the Clerk to the Board and such funds are available in the 2025 Mercer County budget; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the County Executive and Clerk to the Board are hereby authorized to "exercise the option to extend" the Award of Bid Contract with Traffic Lines, Inc., for the installation of pavement markers, raised pavement markers, rumble strips, and signs on County Roads various locations for the Department of Transportation and Infrastructure for the period of November 1, 2025 through December 31, 2026 in the total amount not to exceed \$250,000.00; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk to the Board shall forward a copy of this Resolution to the Mercer County Planning Office and the Mercer County Purchasing Department for further distribution.
