# ORDINANCE NO. 2023-1

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WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Mercer, State of New Jersey, does hereby ordain as follows:

1. The speed limit for both directions of traffic along Bear Tavern Road (County Route 579), Township of Hopewell, be amended as follows:

Zone 1: 45 MPH to 35 MPH from 1000' North of Maddock Road to Washington Crossing-Pennington Road (County Route 546), except for 25 MPH when passing through the Bear Tavern Elementary School Zone, while "25 MPH When Flashing" signs are operating during recess or while children are going to or leaving school during opening or closing hours; thence,


2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon approval by the Board of County Commissioners; and,

3. Regulatory and warning signs shall be erected and maintained to effect the above designated speed limits in accordance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices; now, therefore,

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED, that the Clerk to the Board of County Commissioners forward four (4) certified copies of said Ordinance to the Office of the County Engineer for submission to the Hopewell Township Municipal Clerk and distribution upon approval and one (1) certified copy to the Director, Mercer County Department of Transportation and Infrastructure



# ORDINANCE NO. 2023-2

WHEREAS, the County of Mercer adopted an Ordinance that put load restrictions on structures that were deemed to be structurally deficient, as per Ordinance No. 86-37, adopted December 9, 1986; and,

WHEREAS, an Amendment (Amendment No. 1) to said Ordinance was required due to the replacement of the structurally deficient structures, Ordinance No. 2013-4, adopted March 14, 2013; and,

WHEREAS, an Amendment (Amendment No. 2) to said Ordinance is now required for four (4) additional structures that were replaced and one (1) additional structure that was rerated; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED, BY THE MERCER COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, that:

1. Ordinance No. 2013-4, adopted March 14, 2013, be and is hereby amended (Amendment No. 1) to include the following change in language and additions:

The load limits for a single vehicle on the following Mercer County Bridges and Culverts shall be as follows:

Bridge No. 214.2	Bear Tavern Road Over Jacobs Creek Hopewell Township	Bridge/Culvert Replaced 2014 Load Posting Removed
Bridge No. 216.6	Washington Crossing- Pennington Road Over Woolseys Brook Hopewell Township	Bridge/Culvert Replaced 2019 Load Posting Removed
Bridge 330.1	Alexander Road Over Stony Brook Municipality of Princeton	Bridge/Culvert Replaced 2020 Load Posting Removed
Bridge 6-140.13	Nottingham Way over the Assunpink Creek Hamilton/City of Trenton	Bridge/Culvert Replaced 2015 Load Posting Removed

Bridge No. 862.1	Dutch Neck Road over Bear Brook, East Windsor Township	Bridge/Culvert Rerated 2013 Load Posting Removed
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2. All other terms of Ordinance No. 86-37 shall remain in effect, and this Ordinance shall take effect as provided by Law.
3. The Clerk to the Board shall forward two (2) certified copies of this Ordinance (Amendment No. 2) to the Mercer County Engineer for further distribution, and a copy to the Director of the Mercer County Department of Transportation & Infrastructure.
