Rt. 1 Exit onto Quakerbridge Road/South 533. After 2 miles (through 4 traffic lights), turn left at the Youngs Road traffic light. At the end of Youngs Road, turn right onto Hughes Drive and follow past Mercer County Park entrance. MCCC campus entrance is on the left

Rt. 206 From 206 South, turn left onto Province Line Road (at traffic light). From 206 North, turn right onto Province Line Road. Follow Province Line Road through the next traffic light (Princeton Pike), continue to the next traffic light and turn right onto Quakerbridge Road / South 533. On Quakerbridge Road, follow directions from Route 1 (see above).

I-95/295 Take Interstate 95 (which becomes Interstate 295) to Exit 65A: Sloan Ave. East Continue straight on Sloan Ave. East (becomes Flock Road) to the end. Turn left at traffic light, onto Edinburg Road Continue straight through one traffic light (becomes Old Trenton Road). Take right jug handle that leads to the MCCC campus entrance.

Eligibility Guidelines

Any Mercer County resident age 60 or over may submit **ONE ENTRY** completed within the past three years. Artwork must be the original work of the applicant and must not have been previously entered into the county show.

First-place winners automatically advance to the state competition. One professional and one non-professional first-place winner are accepted in the state show in each of the following categories: acrylic, craft, digital art, mixed media, oil, pastel, photography, print, sculpture, watercolor and works on paper.

Categories

- **Acrylic.**
- **Craft.** One-of-a-kind originals. No kits/molds.
- **Digital Art.** Work created using a computer-based painting or graphics program, such as Photoshop or Illustrator.
- **Mixed Media.** Combines two or more media, no one of which clearly predominates; includes collage and assemblage.
- **Oils.**
- **Pastel.** Includes chalk and oil pastels.
- **Photography.** Created using a film-based, digital or pinhole camera, includes color, black & white, tinted or digitally manipulated photos, photograms, tin types, etc.
- **Print.** ORIGINAL prints including monoprint, woodcut, silkscreen, etching, linoleum block.
- **Sculpture.** “Non-functional” 3-dimensional work in any medium.
- **Watercolor.** Includes gouache & tempera.
- **Works on Paper.** Pencil, pen, ink, graphite and markers.

Artist Classification

Professional: Person who meets 2 or more of the following criteria:

- sold artwork through commercial channels;
- has exhibited in a professional gallery and/or in professional shows for 2 or more years;
- has had work selected for juried shows;
- has received 2 or more awards for artwork;
- holds or has held professional membership in art guild or association.

Non-Professional: Person who does not meet the above professional criteria.

Display Guidelines

- Work must be the original creation of the artist. No giclée prints or other reproductions of original art work will be accepted.
- 2-D dimensions, **including frame:** no more than **MAXIMUM 30”** or less than **MINIMUM 10”** in any direction. No exceptions!
- Sculpture and 3-D crafts **MAXIMUM 20”** in width and **MAXIMUM 36"** in height, and may not weigh more than 40 pounds.
- Sculptures must be attached to bases, if a base is used.
- Artwork must be delivered **READY TO HANG:** matted, framed and wired for hanging (NO SAW-TOOTH HANGERS) and properly labeled on the back.
- Plexiglas is suggested for all 2-D work, when possible, and is **required** for pieces more than 24” in any dimension to avoid accidental damage.
- Artwork valued at \$400 or more must be insured by owner.
- If work is incorrectly categorized, it will be moved to the correct category.
